



CODE PINK: ED

KEY POINTS

ANY time there is a patient imminently delivering OR a baby is newly born:

Transfer patient to Trauma / Acute Bed & **Call a "CODE PINK ED" via
Switchboard: 7111 ASAP!**

Deploy the Resuscitaire (Infant Warmer) to the right side of the Maternal patient

- Plug in the power cord
- Turn on Warmer
- Set up Neopuff & gasses

Assess need for Maternal or Neonatal Resuscitation: consider the need to delegate 2 teams to care for Mom & Baby.
